- 1,0 – very good (A-10-excellent)
- 1,3 – very good (A-10-excellent)
- 1,7 – good (B-25-very good)
- 2,0 – good (B-25-very good)
- 2,3 – good (C-30-good)
- 2,7 – satisfactory (C-30-good)
- 3,0 – satisfactory (D-25-satisfactory)
- 3,3 – satisfactory (D-25-satisfactory)
- 3,7 – sufficient (E-10-sufficient)
- 4,0 – sufficient (E.10-sufficient)
- 5,0 – fail (FX-F)

ECTS grading scale:

ECTS grade	% of successful students normally achieving the grade	Definition
A	10	EXCELLENT – outstanding performance with only minor errors
B	25	VERY GOOD – above the average standard but with some errors
C	30	GOOD – generally sound work with a number of notable errors
D	25	SATISFACTORY – fair but with significant shortcoming
E	10	SUFFICIENT – performance meets the minimum criteria
FX	-	FAIL – some more work required before credit can be awarded
F	-	FAIL – considerable further work is required
